From reed to pellet - from waste to energy



Reed is a natural fast growing "burden" in agriculture. To avoid every years burning of reed, we found another way of making use out of it.





Reeds are harvested in winter, dried down to 15% water content and transported to Stork's Nest location.

Two mechanical treatment steps are necessary –grinding / shredding and pelleting / briquetting.





The final product has a much higher calorific value than willow and equal to beech, is easy to handle and to store.
