



## Medical herbs



Seeds from plants all over the world are tested in the greenhouse, test garden and field. All plants are mainly for the treatment of diabetes, cholesterol and cancer. Seedlings are grown in seed-tables.



At a size of 5 cm are the seedlings replanted into the seedbeds within the green house and fertilised with chicken manure.

At a size of 20 cm is another replant necessary in order to identify how the plant can adapt to the local climate conditions.



Plants are either dried or the further treated for seed and/or seedoil production. No plant was ever in contact with chemicals. Plant breeding, reproduction and pressing of oil are strictly following international rules of bio-organic production.
